María Dolores Olvera Lobo is a full Professor from the University of Granada (Spain). She teaches several courses at the Faculty of Translation and Interpreting and the Faculty of Communication.

She has been involved as main researcher in several projects funded by various national plans: "Application of a professional model for the teaching of translation" (2004-2005, code EA2005- 0023), "PAIMME: Platform for analysis and access to multilingual website information about monuments in Spain" (2013-2015, code HAR2012-38562), "LOCWEB_PYME: WEB LOCALIZATION of Spanish SMEs: support platform for multilingual dissemination from the perspective of translation" (2016-2018 code CSO2015-64532-R) and TRANSCREAWEB: Website Transcreation for the Dissemination of Corporate Information of Health Care Spanish SMEs, ending December 2021. Since 2009, she is the main researcher of the Research Group HUM466 "Access and evaluation of scientific information", to which she belongs since 1997. In addition, she is also currently a member of the Scimago Group (Associated Unit of the Higher Council for Scientific Research, Madrid), the group that created the SCImago Journal Rank (SJR) indicator. She has taken part in 19 research projects funded by various Ministries as well as by the Junta de Andalucía (Spain) and other Autonomous Communities from Spain.

Her research lines are focused on Information Retrieval, advanced systems in information retrieval, specialized documentation, Web 2.0, translators training and information resources for translators. She has published more than 50 articles in national and international specialised journals, of which the vast majority have a relative quality index (JCR, SJR). Among the journals in the field of Documentation where she has published her studies, the following can be cited: Journal of Documentation, Journal of Information Science, Health Information & Libraries Journal, Online Information Review, Information Research, El Profesional de la Información, Revista Española de Documentación Científica, Investi-
